#### **INTENSIVE IN-HOME SERVICES**

The AES Intensive In-Home Services Program is designed to provide extensive guidance and support to children and adolescents who are at risk of removal from the home due to mental, social, emotional and/or behavioral problems.

Intensive In-Home services are provided and monitored by experienced clinicians available to the client 24 hours a day 7 days a week. This is a therapeutic intervention program with a concentrated focus on individual needs of the client and family.

# **Intensive In-Home Services consist of:**

- Comprehensive needs assessment & diagnosis
- Evaluation of mental health needs
- Skills-training and psycho-education and to improve independent living
- Assistance with accessing & navigating community resources
- Individualized treatment plans tailored to specific identified needs
